flow into each other so quickly and so smoothly that I'm sure half of them slipped past me while I was busy chucking at the others. And even so, I never stopped being entertained. There are jokes to please everyone: pop culture references, bad puns, high-brow allusions, raunchy slapstick, and of course plenty of surreal and dark humour. I won't ruin the punchlines in the show, but suffice it to say that they encompassed everything from voles to Helvetica to exorcism. To quote them here would be to ruin the humour, anyway, since so much depends on the comic timing of these gifted young performers.

Not only were the writing and the delivery of the jokes outstanding, but the staging also added to the humour of the show by playing around with the conventions of more traditional drama. The opening scene mocked the melodrama of modern theatre, and
