**PAMPER YOURSELF AT BABY**

"In newly fashionable East Oxford, **Baby** is the perfect one-stop night out. Enjoy the hip, retro cocktail bar (happy hour 5.30pm-7.30pm Monday-Saturday: cocktails from £2.50, generous bowl of olives £1), then adjourn upstairs to the more relaxed ambience of the restaurant. Book the window table and star gaze over the Cowley Road. The menu is 50/50 meat/vegetarian and resolutely modern, featuring Thai, Moroccan and lots of roasted vegetables. The imaginative starters include grilled feta crostini with fig relish: brilliant complementary flavours which would work equally well as a cheese course; stir-fried prawns with Szechuan peppers: labour intensive but worth it. For mains, try the perfect Aberdeen Angus steak with big fat fries and salad, or the succulent Moroccan vegetable terrine with couscous. The short wine list of three reds and three whites is good value (£9-£13). Finish with the roasted peach creme brulee, or cheesecake, and real espresso."
