THEATRE REVIEW

The Knocky, by Michael Wynne
Trinity College Gardens, 7pm, until Saturday 3rd

The ups and downs of life on a London council estate are played out in *The Knocky*, a play by Michael Wynne. In the striking North Quad of Trinity College a white-picket fence cordons off Norma's council house backyard where she holds a 70th birthday party for her mother, Pearl. During the celebrations the happy-go-lucky façade of the family is stripped away and any aspirations for a better life are smashed.

This is possibly the first time council house politics will have been played out alongside architecture by Christopher Wren. However, the intelligent acting of the Trinity Players successfully draws the audience into Pearl's party, complete with 2000 sausage rolls and her daughter Mary's Spice Girl karaoke. Her stoic daughter Norma provides the centre for the play, trying to maintain "dignity with not dribbling" down her face as her house gets burgled and her daughter Lizzie shows signs of being on the game.
