Chisinau National Opera, Apollo Theatre,

The Chisinau National Opera's production of Turandot, presented by Ellen Kent and Opera seems a bit cramped on the set, they make a the emperor of a thousand suns - and add a certain gravitas to the spectacle of Turandot's court. to ritual, striving to imbue the thin lines of Puccini's fairy tale plot with a sense of myth and

neglected either: Turandot is rather an oddity, in that its tragic action is frequently interrupted by the delightful capers of Ping, Pang and Pong, three comic characters quite unnecessary to the plot. It is difficult not to speculate, watching this threesome whose antics seem so incongru ous in what is supposed to be a "Great" tragedy that Puccini owed a debt both for their characterization and their percolating musical trios to those masters of light opera, Gilbert and Sullivan, whose Mikado sparked such a rage for Chinoiserie in the nineteenth century. The choreography cheekily acknowledges this possibility when Ping, Pang and Pong assume a distinct tively coy position with fans in front of face, like three rather corpulent maids from school

slightly threadbare, and the staging a bit muddled at times, but it is thoroughly satisfying in terms of the music and acting. The only possible dissatisfaction is the nagging question, had Puccini lived, how would he have finished the opera? Alfano completed the score with a reprise of "Nessun dorma," and yet it does sit uneasily that Turandot, ice-maiden, killer of so many men, should be so easily thawed, permitted to luxuriate in Calaf's conquering love without any penance for her hideous murders. Turandot is always something of an enigma, with its comic interludes in conflict with the grimness which underpins its archetypal fairy-tale plot, and its air of the belle epoch out of synch with the twentieth century in which it was written, but that is
