

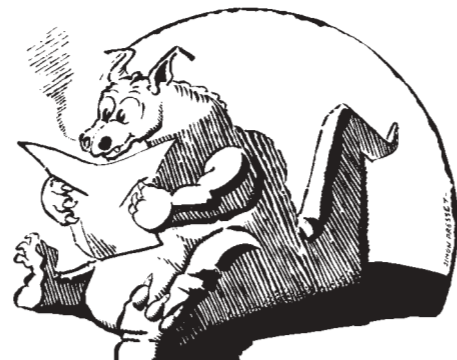

CHRIST CHURCH FESTIVAL ORCHESTRA AND OXFORD GIRLS' CHOIR

CHRIST CHURCH CATHEDRAL, FRIDAY 1 MARCH 2002

Christ Church Festival Orchestra and Oxford Girls' Choir provided an evening of contrasts on Friday 1 March, tackling a programme of Bruckner, Fauré and Messager. Opening with three simple Bruckner motets, the choir, directed by Richard Vendome, captured the richness and drama of Bruckner's harmonies despite a rather functional performance. The choir was dominated by some confident and talented voices, and there was evident enjoyment in the well-known Locus Iste and the roof-raising harmonies of Ecce Sacerdos.

and four Wagner tubas. The orchestra, directed by James Ross, seemed to ease into the work, sometimes initially failing to convey the constantly changing musical colours with sufficient contrast. However, by the third movement the orchestra appeared to feel more comfortable with the acoustic of the cathedral, and in particular, the upper strings came together to produce a rich and dense sound that was perfect for the melodrama of the work. Similarly, the brass section got over problems of intonation to produce a clear and unified sound that cut through the strings' texture.

It was a privilege to hear the rarely-performed Fauré/Messager Messe des Pêcheurs, particularly within the setting of a cathedral. The addition of a small instrumental ensemble contributed a further touch of polish to the choir's performance, sounding through the choral texture to provide a sense of clarity and light to the many colours of the work. Although there were moments when the voices needed to blend together more, choir and ensemble conveyed the simplicity of this brief Mass very effectively.

Despite the drama and passion of the programme, and the obvious talent and enthusiasm of the performers, the concert was initially dominated by problems with the acoustic of the venue. In such an intimate venue as the transept of the cathedral, intonation needed to be perfect, as did understanding of the harmony of the works. However, difficulties of intonation and blending from both choir and orchestra were occasionally uncomfortable. These overcome, the evening proved to be one that highlighted the rich diversity of late nineteenth century music.

Moving from the intimate to the grandiose, the concert was completed by Bruckner's magnificent but unfinished Ninth Symphony, which employed an impressive brass section that included five horns

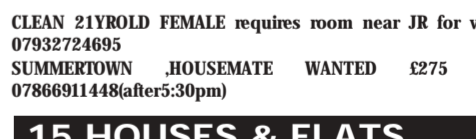
