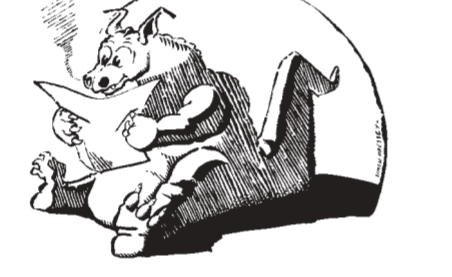

THEATRE REVIEW

Hobson's Choice by The Young Vic Theatre Company
 At the Oxford Playhouses to Sat 6th September

Richard Jones' production of Hobson's Choice by Harold Brighouse showcases a sparkling new adaptation by Tanika Gupta that takes the plot & characters of the original play, set in a 1914 Manchester cobbler's shop, and resets them firmly in a modern Manchester family-run Asian tailor's shop.



It is remarkable how smoothly the marriage worries of a father and his 3 daughters travel the 79-year time span - this central theme supporting explorations of a settled immigrant's perceptions of 2nd generational cultural acclimatisation as his daughters mature into young western women, his distaste for 'phony asylum-seekers' always scrounging off the state' and the difficulties of running a small 21st century British family business.

The show races along throughout, the set changes delightfully covered by brass bhanga beats and snapshot slideshows of the intervening action on the streets of Salford. The Young Vic's extensive set has been somewhat reduced for this national tour, but still delivers engaging spaces for a talented cast to swoon, swear and stand their ground in conflict after conflict. The only weak area of the play's transformation to the modern day was the influence and involvement of the doctor within the family that, notwithstanding her intertwined relationships with various family members, still seems somewhat unconvincing.
 This is all-in-all a terrific night out; be prepared for authentic accents that might strain some older Oxford ears, attitudes that should live firmly in the last century and plenty of moments that will have you holding your sides. Enjoy!
