become a bit messy. However, to focus on the Anything Goes production's handful of faults would be to neglect a litany of achievements.

Especially when the band strikes up and the actors get the chance to sing Porter's rather marvellous collection of songs, they excell. I Get a Kick out of You, You're the Top, It's De-Lovely ... are just that, delovely. And, of course, the bluesy gem Blow, Gabriel, Blow lifted the roof.

Without denying the superb quality of the cast as a whole, a number of particularly well-crafted performances deserve mention. David Leverton is an amusing, and permanently stewed, Elisha Witney; Lauren Birt is scarily convincing as every son-in-law's worst nightmare (and breathes life credibly and comically into her rag of a dog). Sophie Brooks is austere and honest as Hope Harcourt, and makes the most of a less meaty role. John Tomlinson is boyish and charming as Billy Crocker, and Tim Stead is good as the unlucky Public Enemy No. 13. Tristan Worthington quite rightly plays Oakleigh as a very earnest and Englisher than thou tof and - for much of the play - seems to have stepped straight out of an advertisement for Skegness, rudely trailing a giant sword.

> But, opening night belonged to a quite singularly talented young performer, Gugu Mbatha Raw, who sang the role of Reno Sweeney (yes, 'a sexy evangelist turned nightclub singer') like an angel. Her

beautiful voice rang out through the theatre; the tiniest mouse that scurried out of its arched doorway in the furthest corner of the auditorium - and trust me every mouse was moved! - would have heard every word she sang, falling like crystals from above. She oozed charisma and confidence and was every inch the sassy American songstress.

Anything Goes is nevertheless at heart a team effort; everyone in the large cast and crew deserve a swig at the celebratory bottle of champagne that should be uncorked after the run.




