

THEATRE REVIEW
mr peters' connections, by arthur miller
playhouse until saturday 7th

One gets the impression that Arthur Miller is feeling his age. This new play, from the pen which gave us the stark, laden lines and taut drama of *The Crucible* is nothing more nor less than a glimpse inside an old man's dreaming mind. Confused, confusing, and at times veering towards the sentimental, the play moves rapidly in every direction before reaching nowhere at all, and coming to no conclusion whatever. That is not to say that it is not skillfully written. In fact, Miller evokes the half-aware state of mind with an accuracy that can only have been born of careful study. Given that he can only have studied his own dreams, one has to wonder whether *Mr Peters' Connections* might offer a unique insight into the wanderings of the playwright's own psyche.

The entire action of the play occurs in limbo. Mr Peters dozes: as he does so, faces from his past and present life appear and converse with him. But this is not This is your life. For a start, it never seems clear whether Mr Peters has ever really known the people he meets. If he has, are they really who he thinks they are? And are they dead, alive, or imaginary? Mr Peters interacts with them, freed by sleep from his customary taciturnity. But he is really talking to himself, for each character embodies, in his dream, some memory, desire or impression lurking in his subconscious. Some characters, such as the scantily-clad, steamingly attractive old flame Cathy-May, are easy to interpret. Others, such as the Jewish composer anxious about his washing, remain intriguingly incomprehensible throughout.

The writing is, by and large, excitingly brisk and enigmatic, if rather saccharine and heavy-handed in places, and there are some touches of genuine humour. The whole is helped along in this UK premiere production by some admirable acting. John Cullum is endearing and empathetic in the lead role, managing to imbue Mr Peters with great energy while maintaining a sense of the burden of years upon him. The rest of the cast show great skill in being able to act characterfully despite never being sure whether they exist or not, or whether their voice is their own.

Does the play achieve anything? There is certainly very little dramatic interest. If drama be dependent on conflict, then this lack is unsurprising: for there is only one real character, and real conflict surely requires at least two. Mr Peters never finds the "subject" he spends much of the piece looking for. Perhaps, then, the point is that there is no point to be found, either in the dream or in the play.

There is, of course, still the intriguing possibility that *Mr Peters' Connections* offers a glimpse inside the mind of the playwright. If this is the case, what do we learn? That he had a few wild times in his youth; that he feels increasingly out of touch with the modern world; and that, ideally, he would like to be left in peace to have a nap.
