St Scholastica's Day

"Havoc! Havoc! Smrt fast, give gode knocks!"

The St Scholastica's Day Riot began with a brawl at the Wyndesheld Tavern at Carfax (where the Santander Bank now stands). Fighting started when some scholars threw wine in the landlord's face, followed by a quart pot. The riot lasted several days. The townsmen rang the bell of Carfax Tower to summon reinforcements who came armed. The Chancellor immediately ordered the ringing of St Mary's bell, whereupon the scholars of the University mustered with bows and arrows.

On the third day, 2000 or so country people joined in on the town side, crying "Havoc! Havoc! Smrt fast, give gode knocks!", and things really began to get nasty. 63 students were killed, many more injured, and much damage was done to buildings and books.

Although the townspeople won the day, they lost the war, for the University invoked the assistance of the king. For 500 years (until 1825) the Mayor and 63 citizens were obliged to do penance on 10th February, the anniversary of the riot: each had to process to St Mary's, bow before the Vice-Chancellor, and pay a fine of a penny.
