Settin a fictional Eastern European state rica 1944-65, the play centres around eager young communist Hugo on a mission to assassinate charismatic party leader Hoederer who dares to challenge party ideals to form a coalition government with the fastisst and nationalists. This final recourse is an attempt to reconcile the killing with his evolved point of view, and this is what gives the play its climax.

Other notable faults included the overly expansive set that looked like a Mondrian without its colour and the lighting design which was often inexplicably sourced and coloured. The second act included a sunrise which, quite ridiculously, was 'turned off' with the flip a writch on a floor lamp then later turned back on again while at no point the lamp itself was illuminated.

Crime Passionnel is rarely performed, so do consider catching this week's run for that reason alone. Even when the delivery is bumpy, the play makes for a nourishing curate's egg.

Hedda Gabler

Moser Theatre, Wadham College: until Sat 11th November

This is a strong production of a strong play, which succeeds in highlighting the same issues today that is author Henrik Ibsen had intended to reveal rather shockingly in the 1890s. The play is centred on Hedda (Redeca Gibson), depressed by her own boredon and repressed by the powers of society because of her gender. One of the main themes here is the confines of society: the liberties afforded to men in the face of the restriction of those of women. Meanwhile, the events of the play unfoldi two characters from Hedda's past return, providing her mind with an occupation on the one hand - the character is not netter and experience schedenfreude from their increasingly fraught situation - and on the other, satisfying her desire to live.

other, statistying her desire to live. The actors adopt their characters convincingly, with a depth and dimension that so many student productions fail to convey. It is this that enables director Ottoline Seriven to explore the dark comic edge to the murky tragedy, which better conveys how alarmingly close to reality the issues in the plor are. From the very opening, Hedda gains our sympathy despite the harsh nature of her character. The audience finds her in a claustrophobic situation, recently married to a man she does not love and who cannot provide her with the plessures of the high life due to his academic profession (another element of her life which bores her). Rebecca Gibson's excellent acting helps us empathise with Hedda. Unlike in Greek tragedy, where the horor of the student setures into a wild fravory of gore and sorrow from an initially stable situation, one of the saddest elements in this tragedy is that there is almost no change in Hedda's path. She receives little pleasure in her misery, nor does she encounter any great fortune. Despite this, the role is not monotonous or too grave, partly due to Hedda's occasional manic ouburusts, but most of all due to the quality of acting of Rebecca and her fellows – most particularly Judge Brack (Krishna Omkar).
