REVIEW: OPERA

Cavalleria Rusticana & Pagliacci

Last week saw a double bill of opera on offer at the Apollo, and it is brought to the UK stage as a collaboration between Ellen Kent's company, Opera and Ballet International, and the Chisinau National Opera and Ballet.

The Moldovan performers—among them Mihai Munteanu who is something of an institution in his native country—are here to play back-to-back Pietro Mascagni's *Cavalleria rusticana* and Ruggero Leoncavallo's *Pagliacci* (or *Cav* and *Pag*, for ease of pronunciation).

First performed together at the New York Met in 1893, *Cav* and *Pag* (I'm opting for the easy alternative!), have now been inseparable for more than a century, and on viewing the two pieces it is easy to see why.

The juxtaposition of these operas gives relief to their inevitable tragedy—I don't wish to spoil the ending, but you know how these things always turn out! Each lasting little under an hour and a half, *Cavalleria rusticana* and *Pagliacci* contrast well with one another. While each is concerned with love, betrayal, jealousy, and a host of complications of the heart, the presentation of the two is quite different.
