





**REVIEW: OPERA** 

# Cavalleria Rusticana & Pagliacci

**Apollo Theatre** 

Apollo, and it is brought to the UK stage as a collaboration between Ellen Kent's company, Opera and Ballet International, and the Chisinau National Opera and Ballet.

The Moldovan performers—among them Mihai Munteanu who is something of an institution in his native country – are here to play back-to-back Pietro Mascagni's Cavalleria rusticana and Ruggiero Leoncavallo's *Pagliacci* (or *Cav* and Pag, for ease of pronunciation).

Met in 1893, Cav and Pag (I'm opting for the easy alternative!), have now been inseparable for more than a century, and on viewing the two pieces it is easy to see why.

First performed together at the New York

The juxtaposition of these operas gives relief to their inevitable tragedy—I don't wish to spoil the ending, but you know how these things always turn out! Each lasting little under an hour and a half, Cavalleria rusticana and Pagliacci contrast well with one another. While each is concerned with love, betrayal, jealousy, and a host of complications of the heart, the presentation of the two is quite different.

Last week saw a double bill of opera on offer at the The first depicts a peasant community in which placid life has urban violence imposed upon it, and is coloured by a lively realism. Pagliacci (Clowns), on the other hand, is a much more selfconscious piece, with a Greek-style Prologue in place at the beginning, telling the audience, "Life and the theatre are not the same thing at all" (with a little

> helpfromthe surtitles!). Pagliacci is dressed up with clowns (an international troupe of acrobats led by the former Bolshoi Moscow Circus star Ion Stanca) and staged in a way that makes one believe the opera within the opera-though where one ends and the other begins becomes increasingly intriguing as the piece progresses.

The vocal performances are outstanding, hitting the sensitive spot in a way that the physical performances do not always manage to do-though this slight shortcoming is easily made up for by the captivating Chisinau National Orchestra. Conducted by Nicolae Dohotaru, the CNO carry Cav and Pag masterfully around the auditorium, and make going to the operatwice in one night something which cannot be
