THE TARNISHED PHOENIX

with Ben Kingsley and Deborah Morris.
Playhouse, 9th and 10th April

Even the most cynical of anti-romantics would find this uplifting and life-affirming. A piece of pure romance, *The Tarnished Phoenix* tells the story of DH Lawrence and his wife Frieda through letters to friends, diary entries and Lawrence's poems. After just eight weeks of knowing each other, and aside from the fact that Frieda was married with three children, Lawrence and Frieda ran away - first to Germany and then Italy - to start a new, gruelling, difficult and enlightening life together. Their life story proves that for Lawrence it was art that imitated life, and not the other way around. Their incredible travels, poverty, struggles and everyday experiences were, absolutely, his inspiration: a snake drinking at their water trough in one of their rented villas in Italy became an addition to his book of poems on *Birds Beasts and Flowers*; a fleeting return visit to the disliked and depressing England provoked *How Beastly the Bourgeoisie is*. The simplicity of this performance - both actors merely reading from folders - allowed Kingsley and Morris to appear incredibly naturalistic and relaxed. This was especially true of Kingsley, whose confidence and charisma was matched perfectly to the writing of Lawrence - a man who was clearly not lacking in self-assurance; he apparently calmed Frieda's anxieties during the voyage to Australia with the words, "Any boat that I am on will not sink". This self-proclaimed, and later widely renowned, genius was clearly a difficult man to

The Roy Orbison Apollo Theatre

The voice of Roy Orbison is familiar in many forms: from his start in the late '50s singing rock ballads, to his involvement in the supergroup *The Travelling Wilburys*. *The Roy Orbison Story* leads you through his life using his songs as the script. With only small spoken scenes tying together the tale, the still dark figure of Roy sings his way through a life full of success and tragedy in equal measure.

And what a life. A young man from Memphis, with a distinctive voice, runs up against the rock and roll phenomena, takes it on and wins; he finds love early on, is betrayed and then rekindles that love only to lose it again. His career, unstoppable in the early days, falters later in his life, but all the way through the dark quality of his songs, allied to that remarkable voice, kept audiences entranced.

Productions paying homage to great singers sink or swim on the quality of the music, and this show swims along at a rocking pace. In addition to this homage to Roy, we hear from other distinctive sounds of the time. From Bobby Vee through to Bruce Springsteen, a pantheon of stars appears on the stage - supporting the tale and bringing the history of rock and roll to life. Damien Edwards, in the title role, sings impressively, managing to emulate the distinct sounds of the big O and generating great enthusiasm from the audience. Maxine Mazumder as Patsy Cline, Dusty Springfield and Kid Lang, shows off the talent that made her a *Stars in Their Eyes* winner by bringing each character completely and believably to life. There are other good performances, and a great deal of humour - a necessary counterfoil to the tragedy of Orbison's life story. The accessory
