

THEATRE REVIEW

Henri Oguike Dance Company Oxford Playhouse, Sat 11th October

Combining a range of music and movement to create diverse moods the Henri Oguike Dance Company came to the Playhouse to present four contrasting pieces, mixing vibrant movement with storytelling, operatic effect with Latin pulse and social commentary with sheer joyful expres-

The music was the key element, setting the mood for dancers and audience alike. Two lighter, energetic pieces sandwiched the longer, more complex fable of Dido and Aeneas, the hero who Dido voluntarily relinguishes in order that he can fulfil his destiny as founder of Rome. A short, sharp solo by the company's eponymous artistic director and choreographer

completed the programme. Dido & Aeneas is an ambitious project which seeks to relate a story as well as expressing the characters' emotions.

Set to a resounding operatic recorded backing which comes dangerously close to dominating the movement work, the dancing is expressive and superbly timed, yet fails to provide much needed contrast between scenes. There are

intense moments, such as the pathos conveyed by bodies writhing on the floor to the accompaniment of minor chords as Dido expires, but

the piece at times seems laborious and one-paced, prone to lose momentum and at times hard to follow. The shorter pieces sandwiching Dido work better. Front Line is performed to live music - a string quartet performing Shostakovich at the back of the stage. The dancing is vibrant and has good momentum. The


