DANCING BEARS by Nick Thomas Old Fire Station until Sat 19th

"Is there anything to eat or are we going to stand around getting pissed?"

So could be explained many a social gathering - or in the case of Dancing Bears, provide the setting for this new comedy about politics, class, relationships and how they interrelate.

Lola's ambition to discover Ben's murky past is really a pre-text, though, with the most interesting elements of the play lying in the relationships between the characters.

The script is quick and full of one-liners, with which the cast work well, playing off each other fluidly. Clara steals all the best lines, which is perhaps to be expected given her position as an aristocratic communist.
