

# Blood Wedding, by Lorca Pegasus Theatre, 15th and 16th June

revenge has been called pure poetry. It takes a brave director to alter such a play, especially to cut it. But that is what the directors of this production have done, presumably to make it a more competition-like piece. European Youth Theatre Festival in Grenoble. Judging from this warmup night in the Pegasus we should all be booking


script onto tape in the first instance. This is then played back for the actors to add gestures and


