# **PUNTING GUIDE**

### Step 1: Find Your Punt

See dailyinfo.co.uk/guide/punting.htm for a full list of places in Oxford you can hire a punt, including prices and contact details. If you can persuade an (under)graduate to invite you onto theirs, do - it's cheaper. Otherwise you're looking at £13-£20/hr plus deposit.

### Step 2: Punt Your Punt

Cherwell

Stand at the back of the punt, half-facing to the side (probably the right). Hold the pole vertically against the side of the punt, and let it run through your hands until it touches the riverbed. (Swish or experienced punters throw the pole downwards, but we'll save that for the advanced class.) Push the pole downwards and backwards, gently at first, then more forcefully towards the end of the stroke. Try to keep the pole directly behind you, lest you swerve wildly to one side of the river. Let the pole trail behind 'Punting' by Mary Potte

the punt, acting as a rudder to guide the punt. If you need to adjust your course, do so by swinging the pole in the water, in the opposite direction to the one you wish to go (want the punt to veer left? Swing the pole to the right). Finally, retrieve the pole hand over hand, and return to start. If the pole gets stuck, give it a half-twist and a gentle tug to free it.

## Step 3: Stay on the Punt

At some point in every punter's career, s/he will find the punt heading in one direction while the pole stubbornly remains behind. Don't attempt to hang onto it! You've been provided with a paddle for a reason, and the pole will remain rooted in place until you can return. The alternative does not bear contemplating; you will stay hanging over the water while the punt leaves without you. You can remain clinging to the pole like a vertical sloth for quite a while. It will not be long enough - you are going to get wet. By this point, you have lost all semblance of dignity. Try at least to amuse the spectators (and there will be spectators) with a nice big splash. This guide by former O.U. Punting Soc. Sec. Alwyn Collinson, May 2010


