

EXHIBITION REVIEW

Echoes of an Ancient Past prints and paintings by Carys Martin. Wolfson College until 27th October

The Autumn sun threw a soft glow across Wolfson's unrippling little inlet, casting impartial rays across series of prints and paintings with equal benevolence, removing the last traces of their dusty stowage. his unsettled season, viewed through the gallery's vast window, provides a pertinent backdrop to works celebrating time and change. The paintings and prints of Welsh artist Carys Martin are a site-specific orgy of colour, dynamics and pattern whose variegated tones encompass inner and outer experiential realms. Sombre skies crouch over Neolithic stone circles, burial chambers, rock scratchings of man's constant attempts to quantify the natural world's harsh beauty. These man-made forms seem to rise from severe, rugged surfaces concealed beneath the landscape's gentler folds.

Echoing Land Art's purpose, these are 'archæological mappings' of often bleak but mythically beautiful terrains. Within these small frames she rearranges accidental patterns from the layers of landscape, aerial views, archæological finds. Patterns prevail; evidence of that 'ordering' process, both human and cosmic, that intrigues her. In the innocent glory of children lost to tiny rock pools, the pattern of shells is over-layered or underscored by swirling, geometric shapes; painterly relations to Land Art's mix of the disintegrating earth's surface and figments of the mind.

Evanescent layering continues in Carys's internalisation of such landscapes. Fresh from New Mexico, a friend's eyes lit up. To her, the swirling patterns dancing between physical forms, imitating, encompassing them, were like those geometric images attained through closing one's eyes tightly. From these internal beginnings, Mexicans have traced spiralled cave paintings as near-supernatural links between internal and external worlds. Carys was inspired by Neolithic rock carvings, which speak of an ancestral desire to simplify nature's complex fractal forms. Such secret symbols decorate the insides of burial chambers, indicative of their darkly ritualistic purpose, whilst the rocks remain harbours against bleakness, emanating permanence, reassurance.

Aptly, the collagraphic works were the best. A collaged layering of card created contours like maps; the sand layers uniting the prints with their derivation, Blake's miniature worlds. Impressively, the final, printpressing process mimics the earth's tectonic compression.

Carys's recent experimentation with watercolours, however, has made an issue of colour. A not wholly successful veering from organic subtlety to what seemed like a homage to the psychadelic seventies said something of Carys's recent launch into motherhood, (as she herself reflects). But then, that time of internal upheaval and introspection creates its own surreality. At this point, too, a certain fraying of discipline is discernible. But this perhaps maps her own, precarious existence.

This criticism aside, the dynamic sense of existential presence, of cosmic order and disarray are absorbingly portrayed. Indeed, the sunny space provided an apt frame for these works, a harbour against those darker forces. I'd like to go again, when rain and wind oppress that broad window.


