A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM

You could stay in a dusty old room at home this summer and watch Big Brother - but why would you want to do that?

The outdoor stage nestled on the tip of an island leaves room for dreamy reflection and appreciation of the gentle breeze - until the show opens with a bang and the pranks and pyrotechnics begin.

The acting is consistently vibrant. Darren Ormandy as a boisterous Bottom gambols and covets to universal delight.

It is the mortals who dominate this version of the play: those wanting to see ethereal beings swathed in gossamer gowns will have to get used to a different kind of magic.

In many ways A Midsummer Nights Dream exhibits its own construction, displaying its seams through reference to the mechanics' play.

Director Zoe Seaton shines the spotlight on the play's dynamic and comic heart; the (often uncontrollable) laughter of the audience testifies to her success.
