Oxford has long been a favourite setting for fictional crime stories. But a glance at the city's history reveals real-life events every bit as gory as anything Morse and Lewis may have encountered, dating back to the very earliest days of a settlement here. Oxford was in an important strategic position in Saxon Britain; by AD 1000 it had grown into a kind of Saxon conference centre. After repeated sackings by Danes, in 1002 and again in 1009, the town's inhabitants decided to

take their revenge: they captured some of the invaders, including the King of Mercia, and burnt them alive in the streets. Fair Rosamund, mistress of Henry II, fled in penitence to Godstow Nunnery, whose ruins still stand by the Thames just North of Oxford. Reputedly, however, Henry's wife Eleanor would not let the matter rest. In her jealous rage she followed the King to Godstow, where she poisoned and executed him inside the nunnery grounds, on
