THEATRE PREVIEW

Pride and Prejudice
Wadhams Theatre, Tues-Sat 7th week

Pride and Prejudice, the much loved novel by Jane Austen, has been brought to the Oxford stage by the Christian Theatre Company. The company certainly has much to live up to following the huge success of the BBC adaptation (few will forget Colin Firth's evocative emergence from the lake at Pemberley). Translating Austen's rich use of irony, tension, satire and characterisation from the book to the stage is a tough challenge, but Rachael Boak's insightful adaptation, and the talented acting within the CTC take it up well.

The tension inherent in Eliza Bennett's and Mr. Darcy's relationship is compellingly portrayed by Abbey Wright and Alistair Gerrard. Their brief encounter at Longbourne emphasises the subtle uncertainty in Darcy's character in response to Eliza's contempt and disdain. Equally, Gerrard admirably conveys Darcy's stoic nature, although it is somewhat unfortunate that his staidity is reflected in Eliza and Charlotte's dialogue and indeed in general by the supporting cast in that same scene. The energetic giddiness of Lydia's arrival (brought across perfectly by Rachael McNulty) seemed to turn the scene around, injecting liveliness and animation, and showing the cast's acting ability to greatest effect.

The key themes of Pride and Prejudice have been insightfully explored, and the contrast in the nature of Darcy and Eliza's relationship between the early Longbourne encounter and the penultimate scene of the play is particularly well expressed. In the latter, Darcy and Eliza's reactions to each other are intimate and sensitive, reminding the viewer of the romantic sentiments inherent in the Austen's novel. The build-up of anticipation in the relationship is exploited by Gerrard and Wright to provide the powerful climax that the events demand.

The choice of scenes for the preview failed to show the complete spectrum of the cast's ability (the Bennets were almost entirely omitted from the preview), and having heard reports of Alex Runchman's emphatic Mr. Collins, this reviewer is convinced that there is still a great deal held back for the performances this week. The staidity of the first previewed scene remains a concern, though, I am yet to see how Mr Collins and Mrs. Bennett will fare in creating the satirical element that the preview lacked. Overall, this talented CTC cast should make the adaptation successful, and for those who enjoyed the novel and BBC production, a visit to the Moser Theatre should provide an enjoyable evening.

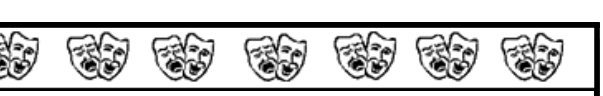

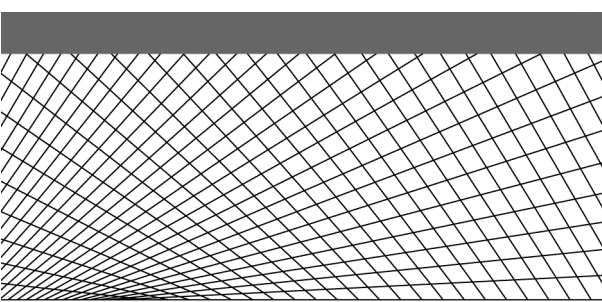

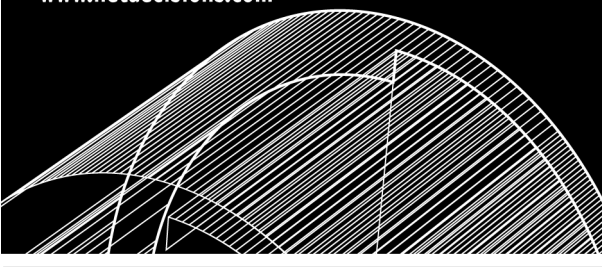
