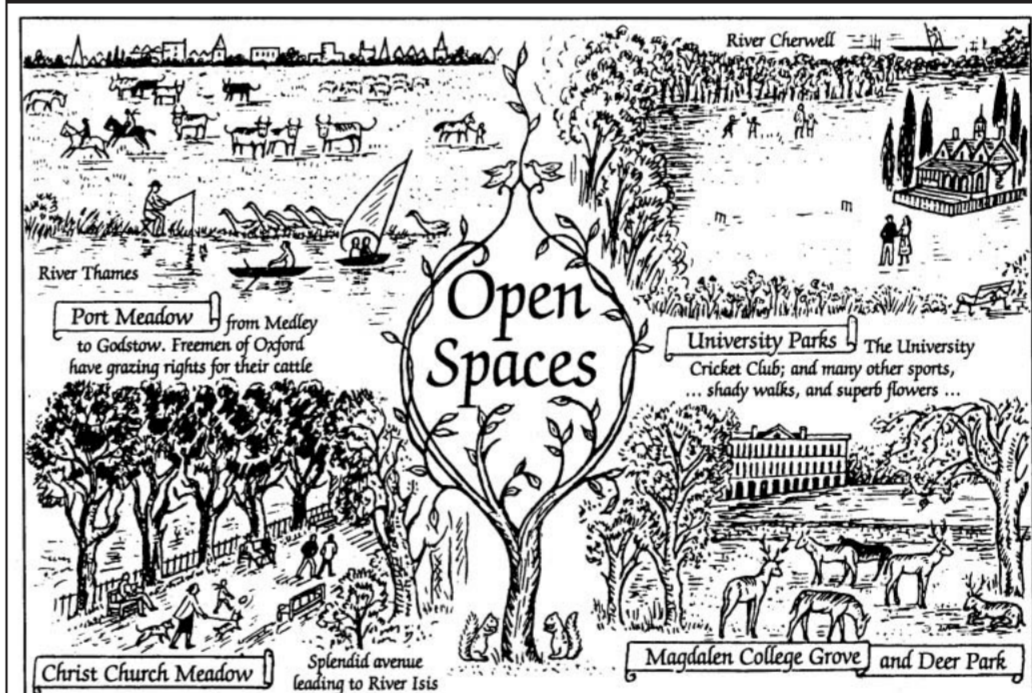

OXFORD HISTORY



1. 'The Parks, opposite Keble, are what is,
in any other town, called a park,' (Betsjeman).
The policy of the curators has been to pro-
vide "as many interesting trees as possible
without detracting from the natural beauty of
the indigenous by an excess of the exotic".
2. It is alarming to contemplate the threat that
overshadowed Christ Church Meadow for
much of the latter part of the 20th century. In
1933, it was suggested that a four lane high-
way be built across it to relieve Oxford traf-
fic, and proposals for a sunken road were still
being put forward in 1968. The combined
efforts of the citizens and past and present
members of Christ Church (including seven
members of the cabinet) eventually squashed
any suggestion of such a scheme.
3. Magdalen Deer Park is first mentioned
in 1706, and even today the college has
a reputation for its venison. Nearby is the
'Magdalen Plane' which is 185 years old, and
the entrance to the 'Water Walks' or 'Addi-
son's Walks' - a delightful circuit of about a
mile, which takes you along the river banks.
4. Port Meadow is a natural grazing ground
whose use has remained unchanged for 900
years or so. Now used by private horse owners
and riding schools, the meadow was for cen-
turies a popular site for horse racing. By the
mid 18th century, race meetings had become
important social occasions, estimated to be
worth over £2000 to the city in trade. The last
race meeting was in 1880, after 40 years of
dispute over rights to use the meadow.
