REVIEW : OPERA

Madame Butterfly, Puccini
Apollo, 18th-19th May

Despite distractions from the audience (a mobile phone that went off three times, digital watches, rustling of keys and coins, the eating of hamburgers), Puccini's masterpiece Madame Butterfly was brought vividly to life by Chisinau National Opera at the Apollo this weekend.

A Japanese house complete with sliding screens, water garden and family shrine served as the background for the classic tale of love and loss. Manami Hama excelled in the title role: fragile and charming in the First Act, she revealed her considerable acting talents in the Second and Third, in a sequence culminating in a particularly poignant final farewell to her young son. The beauty and power of her voice never faltered throughout the wide range required of her by a demanding score. She was complimented well by Alexei Repincshii as Pinkerton, and their fantastic top Cs sung in unison, which bring the First Act to a close, provided what was perhaps the musical highlight of the evening. Tatiana Busuico as Suzuki and Vladimir Dragos as Sharpless matched the leads in the quality of their singing and empathy with their roles.

The first half was fairly static, though there were some excellent comic touches neatly executed by the marriage broker Goro (Vasilie Micusa). Special mention should also be made of the women's chorus: attention had clearly been paid to the graceful nuances of Japanese manner. After the interval, however, the movement of the actors was freer and the piece more dynamic. The moving interchanges between Butterfly and Suzuki and later Pinkerton, Suzuki and Sharpless were well directed.

Conductor Nicolae Dobotaru interpreted the score excellently, getting the best out of a fine orchestra and accomplished singers. Although the direction did not always match the high quality of the music, nonetheless charming costumes and set and some really excellent individual performances made this a great night at the opera.
