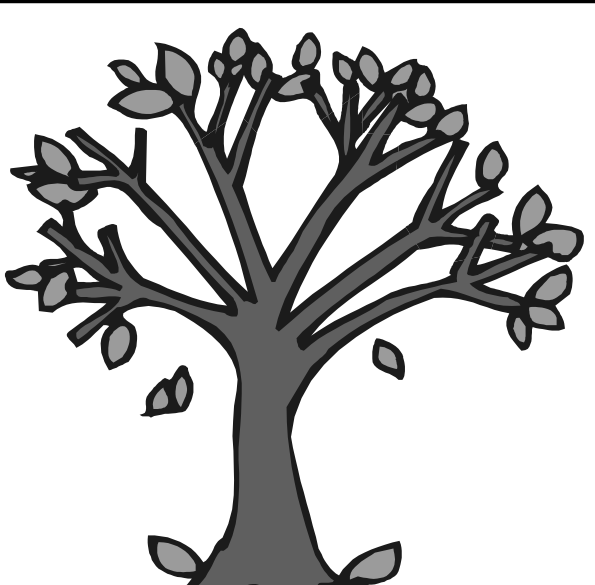

This is a limerick by Ronald Knox, which demonstrates one of the popular misconceptions of Berkeley's philosophy. In fact, Berkeley's claim would be that the material quad does not exist at all as an independent object. Strictly speaking, it exists neither when somebody is in the quad nor nobody is in the quad. What *does* exist, even when nobody is in the quad, is an archetype of the quad in God's mind. This 'archetype' may be thought of as God's private notebook about what the quad looks like. When people subsequently go into the quad, they will find themselves having the appropriate mental experiences (referred to as 'perceiving the quad'). Those experiences are produced by God with reference to His archetype - in a manner similar to that in which musical sounds are produced by a skilled musician with reference to a printed musical score.
