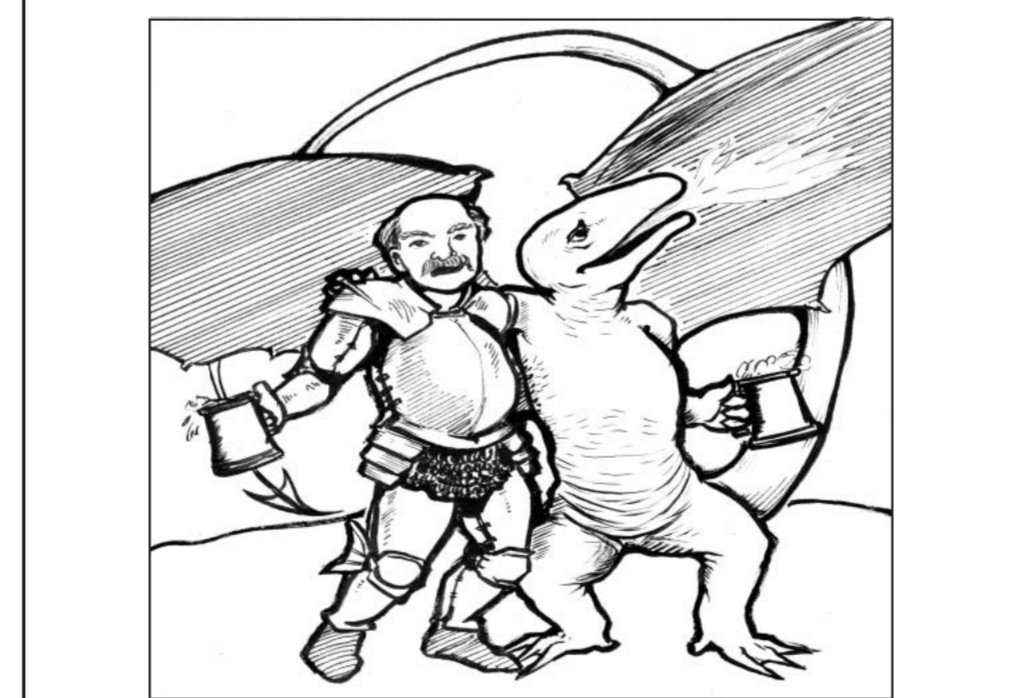

TODAY IS ST GEORGE'S DAY



The life of Saint George is shrouded in legend, so much so that it is quite difficult to untangle fact from fiction. A few facts are known though: He was born in Cappadocia of noble birth, to Christian parents and on the death of his father accompanied his mother to Palestine, her country of origin, where she had land and George was to run the estate. He held an important post in the Roman army - the rank of tribune, or perhaps colonel in modern terms - during the reign of the Emperor Dioclesian (245-313). Dioclesian was a great persecutor of Christians (from about 302) and when the persecutions began George put aside his office and complained personally to the Emperor of the harshness of his decrees and the dreadful purges of Christians. For his trouble, though, he was thrown into prison and tortured. He would not recant his faith however and the following day he was dragged through the streets and beheaded. He was martyred at Lydda in Palestine (Nicomedia). It is uncertain whether he also tore down the Emperor's decrees as they were posted in Nicomedia. So was he one of the first to perish. The Emperor's wife, Alexandria was so impressed at the Saint's courage that she became a Christian and so too was put to death for her trouble.

Due to his chivalrous behavior (protecting women, fighting evil, dependence on faith, and might of arms, largesse to the poor), devotion to Saint George became popular in the Europe after the 10th century. In the 15th century his feast day was equated with Christmas. The celebrated K nights of the Garter are actually K nights of the Order of Saint George. The shrine built for his relics at Lydda, Palestine was a popular point of pilgrimage for centuries.
