

OXFORD HISTORY



Oxford contains a plethora of curious and historical street names, and while the significance of some may be lost to posterity, the origins of many can be elucidated. Crotch Crescent, for example, was named after Dr William Crotch, organist at Christ Church during the 18th Century. Holywell Street passes over the site of the "Holy Well", said to have sprung up when Oxford's patron saint, Frideswide, struck the ground with her staff.

Over the ages, town planners have occasionally thought it necessary to censor the more salacious of the historical road names: what is now known as Magpie Lane was originally dubbed Grope Street, a less than subtle reference to the profession of the ladies who tended to congregate there.
