RESTAURANT REVIEW

Zizzi's, 59 George Street

I always think of Zizzis as a Pizza restaurant, and while it does have a range of salads, meat dishes and pasta option I aways mink of JCZSs as a Picza restaurant, and while it loos have a range of sales, meet dense an passa optoris on offer, if she pizzas which seem to buil in the punities. In my opinion the pizzas are definitely amongst the best in Oxford, with a good range of toppings available and excellent thin and crispy bases. I have heard multerings that perhaps the toppings are allited thin on the ground but, despite being an adherent to the school of hought that there's really no such thing as too much food, I've never found this to be a problem. I would be deeply embarrassed to even thint at how many 'ZIZSI pizzas I have consumed during my fixe at Oxford and have enjoyed all of them. Particular favourities of mine are the Sofia (chicken, bacon, peoperoni, yum!) and the Capriciosia (prosclutch ham, egg, ancho-vies, olives stc). Both are very good indeed. I have one tip though – if you go for one of their garlic pizza breads as a starter, definitely share it as it literally is an entire pizza base. I don't want to come over all' D' Alkins' but one of these plus a pizza would be a bit carb-rich for anyone!
