Most of the show is quirky and very British (Northern even) in tone and what you find funny depends on personal outlook. The deadpan delivery means that the humour is slow burning and catches up with you when you least expect it. I found myself chuckling about the odd throwaway line long after the show had finished. And I can't seem to stop humming the 'Austin Ambassador Y reg' song...
