THEATRE REVIEW Rose Rage, Part I Oxford Playhouse Edward Hall and Roger Warren have somehow managed to turn Shakespeare's Henry VI Parts I and II into a lucid and approachable evening of theatre that handily doubles as a history lesson.

Despite the complex subject matter of ancient bickering and power struggles, the production is full of energy, and the cast present an array of characters who, if not always appealing, are certainly convincing.

Jack Cade, leader of the rebellion that evolves in the power vacuum, is portrayed with powerfully persuasive charisma by Tony Bell. Presented within an industrial, twentieth-century set, this charisma is unnerving, to say the least.

The production is eased along by an ingenious use of sound and music, ensuring that scenes progress seamlessly, and creating all sorts of helpful links within and beyond the plot.

Part II, (Thursday - Saturday) promises to be similarly enlightening.
