





This production of the Nutcracker is a contrast between some very traditional elements (the settings and most of the choreography follow the classic Grigorovich ballet) and some major departures from the standard version. The most notable of these is that, perhaps due to a lack of principal soloists in the company, the Snow Queen and the Sugar Plum Fairy have been written out altogether. This means that the latter half of the ballet loses many of its story telling aspects, becoming merely a sequence of set pieces, although generally well executed. It also means that the weight of the ballet falls almost entirely on the dancer dancing Marie (sometimes known as Clara) who adds the dance of the Sugar Plum Fairy to her traditional role. In general, she carries this off pretty well although there was little chemistry between her and the Nutcracker prince in their pas de deux. The dance of the snowflakes and dance of the sweets both suffered rather from the lack of a focus, but in general they managed to carry the changes off reasonably well.


