Alan's cynical tirades against political correctness ('Single mothers' What about en'el Lora have impregnated more than two dozen of the sluts this year!) received an almost unintelligible positive response (I hope the play doesn's slowly gain a following of BNP supporters taking it at face value). Holding the show up as an example of satire in the great tradition alongside work by Dario Fo, Bernard Shaw, Chris Morris and Armando lanucci (as the printed programme does) is hubristic During the first years of New Labour, it's true, political satire fell out of popular vogue, but in the government's declinier.

Roy Brenner and even Little Britain have familiarised us with the lampooning of all aspects of modern UK politics. The New Statesman's caricature of our current sate adaly doesn't show us anything we haven't already seen done better, cleverer, and funnier.

One first becomes suspicious of this particular production of the 1965 Jee Otton classic on reading the programme. This contains a nother self-conscious directorial statement and also, referring to the coffin used in the production, an odvertisement for a local fineral director—induding its phone number! Nevertheless, I have seen Loot performed before and use utiling to give this production the benefit of the doubt. And the production did deliver in some areas. Charles Reston usa convincing as the ridiculous inspector Tuscott, while Tom Profumo played the elderly uildow McLeony with considerable spirit. Moreover, Klote Starfs (ope a chroucylly admirable performance as a corpsel

The production did suffer, however, from firstnight nerves. Latte Wakeham, who played the
wicked nurse Fay, stumbled over her lines and
gave a rather static performance, while Nick Budd, who played McLeavy's reprobate but perversely honest son Hal, lacked comic timing, despite his physical resemblance to Harry Enfield. However these weaknesses may well be ironed out as the actors relax and grow into their roles.

Nevertheless, on this night, the production as a whole suffered from a lack of pace, which is needed in order to do justice to Ortan's wilty stript.
