oused in the courtyard of the Story Museum, Broken Spoke exist to promote cycling culture in Oxford, ditching smelly cars and putting people on bikes to get active and moving. Broken Spoke are not a normal bike shop or a repair centre, they run as a not-for-profit cooperative centred around their staff, volunteers and

bike lovers everywhere. They run lots of bikerelated classes teaching repairs, riding skills and bike maintenance, but the main feature is the weekend drop-in sessions. Run as an open workshop, anyone is welcome to go in and pay a small fee to have use of the space and every tool imaginable.
