Where to Stay

The Oxford area code is 01865. From abroad, dial +44 1865 and then the phone number.

Visitors to Oxford often ask "Where is the University?" The answer is, "You're standing in it!" Unlike most universities, which tend to be purpose-built on distinct integrated sites, the University of Oxford has evolved as a sprawling federation of largely autonomous colleges, which, for the most part, are found in the centre of the city. Each college has its own rules and constitution, and individuals are at the University of Oxford only by virtue of their membership of a college. Our other University, Oxford Brookes, exists independently and has a dual campus in Headington (Gypsy Lane and Headington Hill); see East Oxford map C4/D4, one (Harcourt Hill) in South East Oxford (see Oxfordshire map C5) and one in Wheatley (see Oxfordshire map E4). Private and institutional student housing for both universities is scattered throughout the city, and it's rarely more than a 5-minute bike ride from bed to lecture hall for any student.
