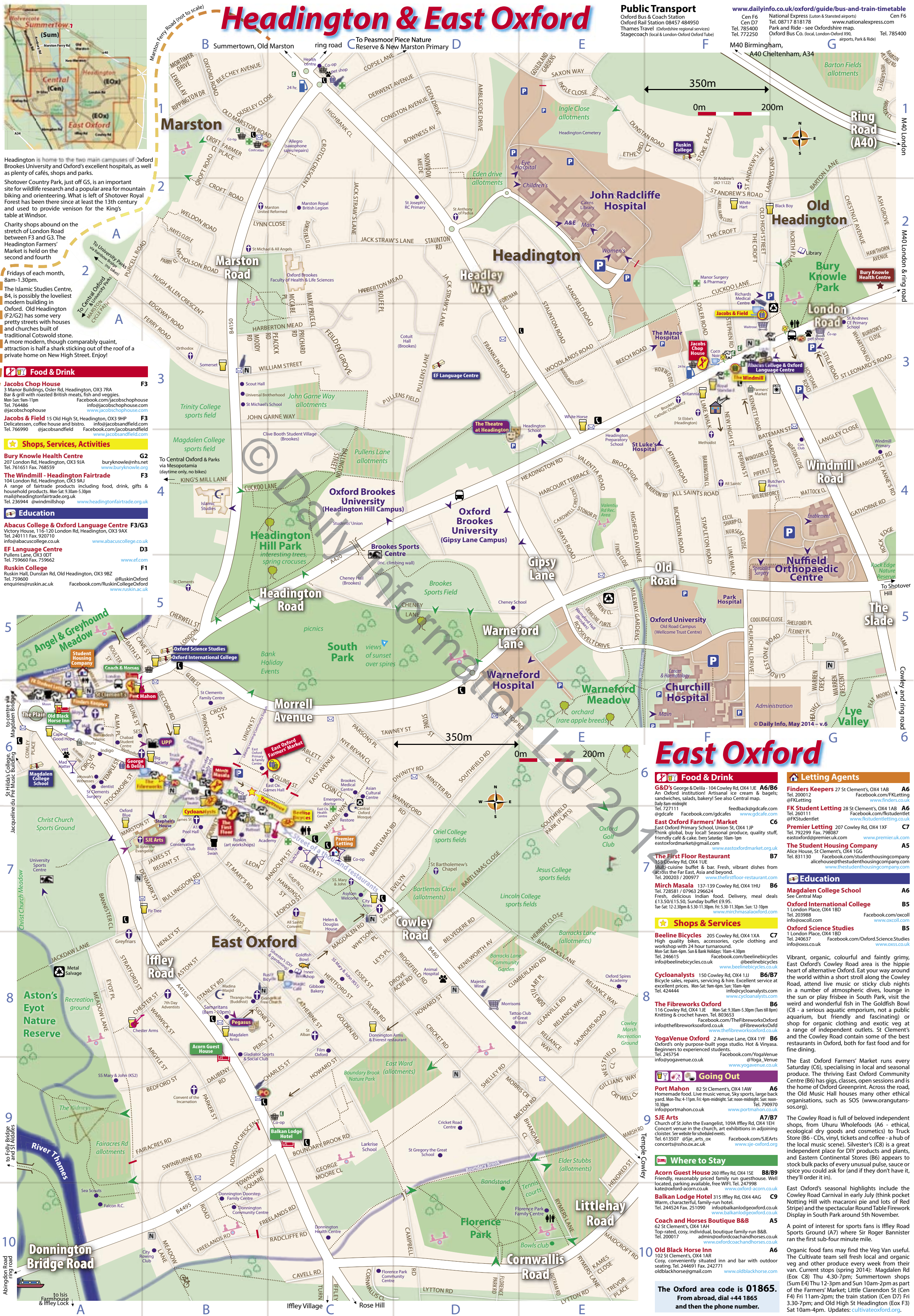

Headington is home to the two main campuses of Oxford Brookes University and Oxford's excellent hospitals, as well as plenty of cafes, shops and parks.

Shotover Country Park, just off G5, is an important site for wildlife research and a popular area for mountain biking and orienteering. What is left of Shotover Royal Forest has been there since at least the 13th century and used to provide venison for the King's table at Windsor.

Charity shops abound on the stretch of London Road between F3 and G3. The Headington Farmers' Market is held on the second and fourth Fridays of each month, 8am-1.30pm.

The Islamic Studies Centre, B4, is possibly the loveliest modern building in Oxford. Old Headington (F2/G2) has some very pretty streets with houses and churches built of traditional Cotswold stone. A more modern, though comparably quaint, attraction is half a shark sticking out of the roof of a private home on New High Street. Enjoy!

Education

Vibrant, organic, colourful and faintly grimy, East Oxford's Cowley Road area is the hippie heart of alternative Oxford. Eat your way around the world within a short stroll along the Cowley Road, attend live music or sticky club nights in a number of atmospheric dives, lounge in the sun or play frisbee in South Park, visit the weird and wonderful fish in the Goldfish Bowl (C8 - a serious aquatic emporium, not a public aquarium, but friendly and fascinating) or shop for organic clothing and exotic veg at a range of independent outlets. St Clement's and the Cowley Road contain some of the best restaurants in Oxford, both for fast food and for fine dining.

Education

The East Oxford Farmers' Market runs every Saturday (C6), specialising in local and seasonal produce. The thriving East Oxford Community Centre (B6) has gigs, classes, open sessions and is the home of Oxford Greenprint. Across the road, the Old Music Hall houses many other ethical organisations, such as SOS (www.orangutantsos.org).

The Cowley Road is full of beloved independent shops, from Uhuru Wholefoods (A6 - ethical, ecological dry goods and cosmetics) to Truck Store (B6 - CDs, vinyl, tickets and coffee - a hub of the local music scene). Silvester's (C8) is a great independent place for DIY products and plants, and Eastern Continental Stores (B6) appears to stock bulk packs of every unusual pulse, sauce or spice you could ask for (and if they don't have it, they'll order it in).

Education

East Oxford's seasonal highlights include the Cowley Road Carnival in early July (think pocket Notting Hill with macaroni pie and lots of Red Stripe) and the spectacular Round Table Firework Display in South Park around 5th November.

A point of interest for sports fans is Ifley Road Sports Ground (A7) where Sir Roger Bannister ran the first sub-four minute mile.

Organic food fans may find the Veg Van useful. The Cultivate team sell fresh local and organic veg and other produce every week from their van. Current stops (spring 2014): Magdalen Rd (Eox C8) Thu 4.30-7pm; Summertown shops (Sum E4) Thu 12-3pm and Sun 10am-2pm as part of the Farmers' Market; Little Clarendon St (Cen F4) Fri 11am-2pm; the train station (Cen D7) Fri 3.30-7pm; and Old High St Headington (Eox F3) Sat 10am-4pm.
