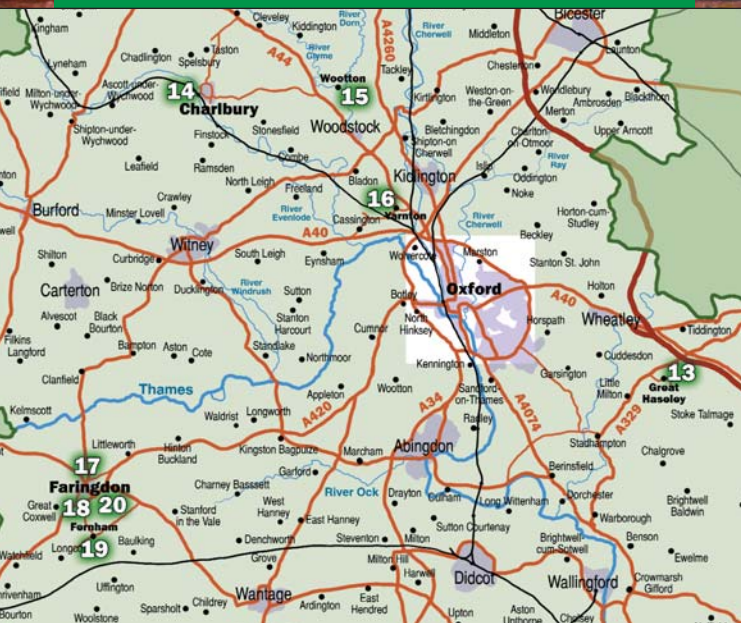

Garden office and spare room built from straw bales and recycled materials. Wood burner, compost loo and Warmcell insulation in roof and floor. **Open:** Sat 13<sup>th</sup> 2pm-6pm

18th century listed villa featuring wood pellet heating scheme, rainwater harvesting, insulation and heat exchange unit. **Open:** Thu 11<sup>th</sup> 4pm-7pm

House renovation plus three storey Eco new-build alongside. Both feature external wall insulation, recycled windows triple glazed, super insulated loft, heat recovery ventilation, solar panels **Open:** Sun 14<sup>th</sup> 10am-4pm

New build straw-bale building, grey-water system, natural 'dam' floor. **Open:** Thu 11<sup>th</sup> 10am-3pm

Opposite Wolvercote Green and the Plough Pub, just South of Wolvercote Lock and Godstow Road. (Nearest parking on Godstow Road or by the Plough.) Narrow boat running on veg oil, fitted using reclaimed materials, solar power, compost toilet, 'greenhouse', wood fired heating and hot water. **Open:** Sat 13<sup>th</sup> & Sun 14<sup>th</sup> 10am-4pm

Piccadilly Back Way, Great Haseley, Oxford,  
Ox44 7JP (off M40 Junction 7)



17th Century cottage with wood boiler for heating and hot water, breathable eco-insulation systems; underfloor heating; thermal mass to store heat; solar panels; innovative eco-materials; 90% CO<sub>2</sub> emissions reductions. **Open:** Sat 13<sup>th</sup> 10am-1pm & 2pm-4.30pm

Many features and superb insulation help this 1993 new build house use one quarter of the energy of a home of this size. **Open:** Sat 13<sup>th</sup> 10.30am-4.30pm

17th century cottage with woodpellet boiler, in-wall heating system, breathable eco-insulation (clayplaster, reed board, cotton-hemp, lime screed) and other eco-materials (low E windows, ecopaint, sustainable oak floors, water/energy saving appliances). **Open:** Fri 12<sup>th</sup> 10am-1pm & Sun 14<sup>th</sup> 10am-1pm

Windmill Barn  
Cassington Road, Yarnton,  
OX5 1QD (far end from the Turnpike, on the A44)



Rainwater irrigation system (1200 litre) to enable rain water storage above ground. Cost effective, suitable for a medium sized garden. Water pump for water usage in house and garden. **Open:** Sun 14<sup>th</sup> 10 am-4pm

Solar thermal and PV panels for water and electricity, Condensing boiler, Cavity wall and loft insulation, low energy lighting throughout. **Open:** Sat 13<sup>th</sup> & Sun 14<sup>th</sup> 10am-4pm

Passive solar gain, with Solar thermal water heating, Green roof, triple glazing, under-floor heating, wood-burning stoves, condensing boiler, wall & loft insulation, Low energy lighting throughout. Eco-extension built to AECB Silver Energy performance standard. **Open:** Sat 13<sup>th</sup> 10am-4pm
